

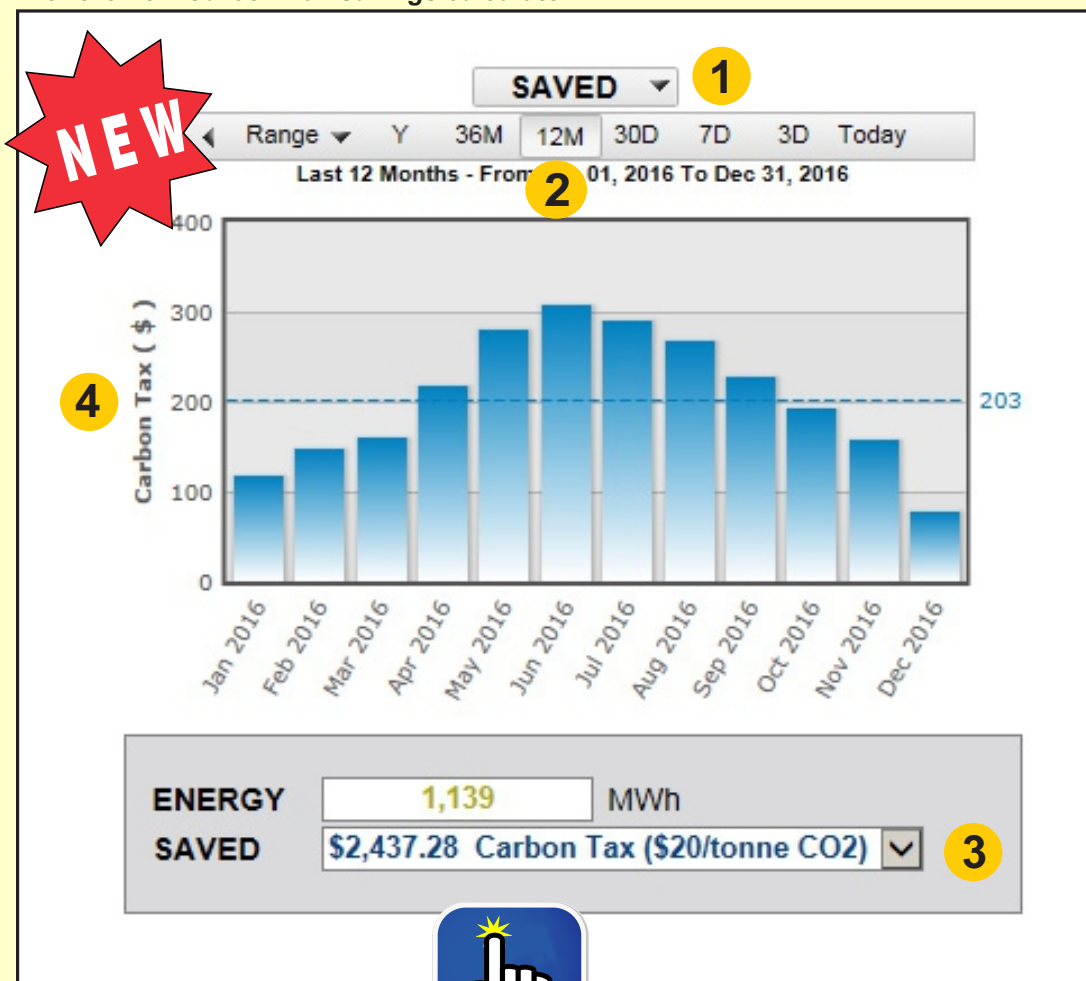
Renewables Don't Pay Carbon Taxes

Drivers are experiencing sticker shock as they fill up in 2017 and pay the new carbon tax on fossil fuels which adds almost 5 cents per litre in Ontario. Home owners are seeing the impact of carbon taxes on their heating and electricity bills. While consumers can't do anything about these new taxes until the next election, owners of solar PV generation sites can take comfort that the electricity they generate is not subject to this additional tax. Use the new SolarVu Carbon Tax calculator, now available on all SolarVu energy portals, to determine how much would otherwise be subject to carbon taxes if generation was from fossil fuels.
